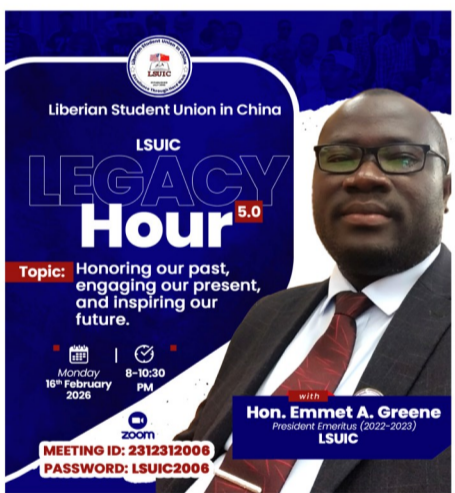
## LSUIC COC CONFIRMS THREE (3) PRESIDENTIAL APPOINTEES AFTER PUBLIC HEARING.

The 6th Council of Coordinators of the Liberian Student Union in China (LSUIC) has officially confirmed three presidential appointees following a public confirmation hearing held on February 1, 2026. In line with Article 15(a) of the Union's 2020 amended Constitution, the Council convened with a full quorum to ensure due process, transparency, and democratic governance. Nominees Ms. Louise Williams (Adjudicator II, Changsha), Emmanuel N. Luma (City President, Dalian), and James T. Kpade-

hya (City President, Mianyang) took the Oath of Proclamation, delivered statements, and responded to questions from Council members and observers. During proceedings, Kpadehya received a ¥25 disciplinary fine for breaching decorum, which he acknowledged and settled. Following deliberations and verification of membership and financial standing, all three nominees secured majority approval and were formally confirmed, reaffirming LSUIC's commitment to accountability and institutional excellence.



## LEGACY HOUR 5.0: HON GREENE REFLECTS ON LEADERSHIP AND LSUIC'S FUTURE



The Liberian Student Union in China (LSUIC) hosted a compelling edition of Legacy Hour 5.0 on Monday, February 16, 2026, bringing together members nationwide for a reflective and forward-looking dialogue. The virtual forum featured Hon. Emmet A. Greene, President Emeritus (2022-2023), who shared candid insights from his tenure.
