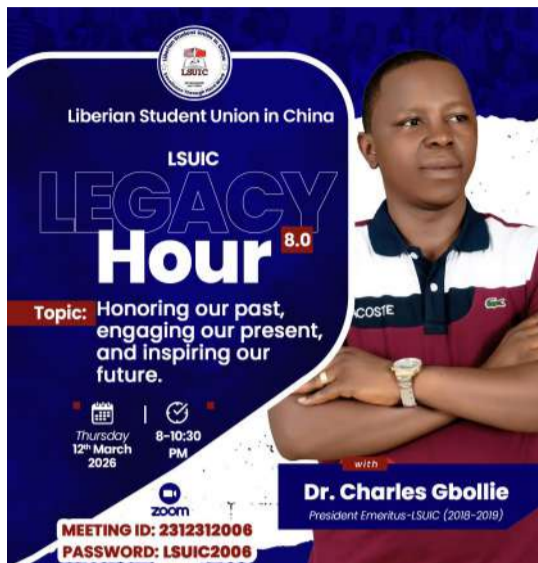

DR. CHARLES GBOLLIE INSPIRES NEW GENERATION OF LIBERIAN LEADERS IN CHINA



LSUIC held its 8th edition of the Legacy Hour, featuring President Emeritus Dr. Charles Gbollie, who shared his experiences as LSUIC president from 2018 to 2019. He highlighted achievements, including clearing the union's debt, organizing a successful conference in Xu-zhou, establishing various committees, and launching educational initiatives. He discussed challenges faced during his leadership, including financial difficulties inherited from previous leadership and the

tragic loss of a student. Dr. Gbollie emphasized the importance of building professional networks while studying abroad and preparing for successful transitions back to Liberia. He encouraged the current leadership to maintain a strong commitment to the union's goals and emphasized the importance of consistent, dedicated work for future success. The event included a Q&A session where Dr. Gbollie discussed his future thoughts, and his recommendations for the current leadership.

LSUIC NATIONAL CHAPLAINCY EMPOWERS STUDENTS TO HARVEST THEIR FULL POTENTIAL

The National Chaplaincy held a seminar titled "Harvesting the Fruits of Your Full Potential" on March 14, featuring two speakers discussing how to unlock and utilize one's true potential. The first speaker, Hon. Mitchell (National Chaplain General – LSUIC), presented on "self-discovery and accessing true potential from a biblical perspective", using agricultural terminology to explain how potential grows when nurtured in the right environment with proper coaching. The second

speaker, Beyan Keflo Jr., shared practical applications and strategies for discovering and mastering one's potential, emphasizing the importance of building a relationship with God, seeking appropriate mentors, and developing discipline. The seminar included interactive Q&A sessions where participants discussed challenges like identifying one's true purpose, overcoming self-doubt, and finding opportunities despite limited resources. The event concluded with prayers led by McClain.

HON. BLOH APPOINTS SCHOLAR KAYCEE KARSOR AS ZHENJIANG CITY PRESIDENT



Pursuant to Article 14 (1)(e) and Article 29 (1) of the 2020 Amended LSUIC Constitution, and in accordance with the authority vested in the National President, Scholar Kaycee Karsor, has been appointed as the President for Zhenjiang City, pending confirmation by the Council of Coordinators (CoC).

Scholar Karsor, a student at the Jiangsu University, Zhenjiang City, Jiangsu Province studying Business Administration said, "It's an honor to serve, as we aimed to achieve Excellence through hard work. I'll definitely serve with dignity and in line with the Constitution".

THE NATIONAL PRESIDENT ENGAGES CITY PRESIDENTS AHEAD OF 3RD QUARTER MEETING

In Demonstrating steadfast leadership, the National President of the Liberian Student Union in China (LSUIC), Hon. Olano Teah Bloh, convened a meeting with the City Presidents on March 19, 2026, an assembly of over 34 city presidents to assess progress and forge a unified path forward. In a spirit of accountability, the Presidents presented their third-quarter updates, including self-evaluation of their service to Scholars in their respective Cities/Chapters. The assembly tackled critical priorities, such as strengthening membership drives by adding Scholars from their Cities. This resulted in the LSUIC 2025-2026 Social

Group-2 having 455 Scholars; as Group-1 already has 500 Scholars, enforcing due payments, and maximizing approved budgetary support for city and provincial initiatives. Despite reported challenges and constraints with student engagement, successes in student loans, academic support, and cultural programs underscored the union's indispensable role. With a clear mandate, leaders are committed to expanding membership registration, driving 50% due payment compliance, and mobilizing for the upcoming national conference, ensuring LSUIC remains a beacon of unity and opportunity for every Liberian scholar abroad.

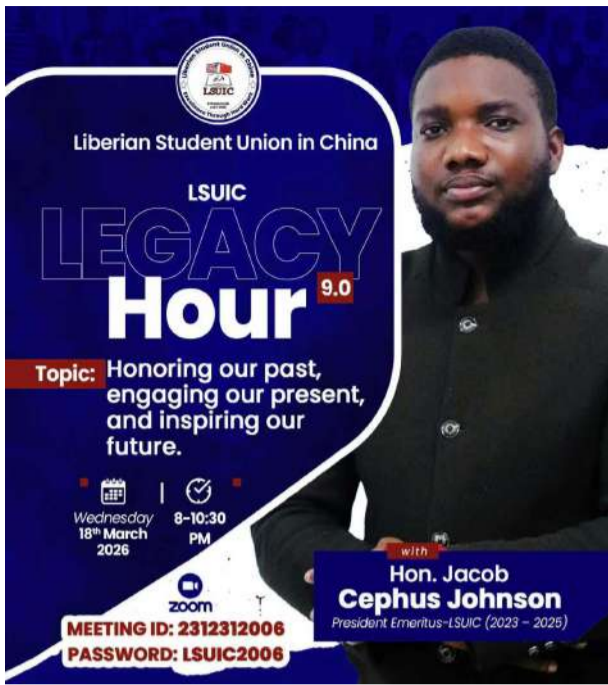

HON. JOHNSON REFLECTS ON HIS TRANSFORMATIVE LEADERSHIP AS LSUIC NEARS 20 YEARS



The Liberian Student Union in China (LSUIC) continues its series of honoring our past, engaging our present, and inspiring our future. A cherished series honoring past presidents as the organization approaches two decades of service to Liberian Scholars in China. The 9th edition of the Legacy Hour honored president emeritus Hon. Jacob Cephus Johnson, who served from 2023 to 2025, and reflected on his journey since arriving in China in 2018. He highlighted achievements during his two-term presidency, in-

cluding implementing financial management programs, the Presidential Award of Service, and organizing successful conferences that generated significant funds. Hon. Johnson addressed reduced public visibility after his resignation, noting he continues supporting the union behind the scenes amid personal and professional commitments. During the Q&A, he expressed regret over not registering LSUIC as a legal entity due to NEC concerns and advised current leaders to balance constitutional authority with collaborative decision-making.

LSUIC BACK-TO-SCHOOL PROGRAM IGNITES SPIRIT OF UNITY AND TALENT

The LSUIC Back-To-School program was held on March 21st, hosted by Hon. Helen Kwia, featuring a historical and insightful sharing from the National President Olano Teah Bloh, who provided an overview of the organization's history, current leadership, and achievements. The program included musical performances by Anpheous and Gracie, a spoken word performance by Hon. Queenetta Dearest Johnson, Secretary of the Academic Excellence Committee of LSUIC, and a pic-

ture-matching game with cash prizes sponsored by Program and Planning Committee (PPC) Co-Chair Hon. Lydia T. Pennoh. Winners included Faith T. Titus, Abdul Corneh, Charles Kollie, Hon. Flomo Peter Gbonyea, and Olive Kamara, among others. The event also announced the formation of a new talent recognition program named "LSUIC Voice" led by the National Vice President Hon. Ruphine M. Harmon, with plans for performances at upcoming events and the annual general conference.



LSUIC FINANCIAL TEAM EQUIPS STUDENTS WITH WEALTH-BUILDING WISDOM

The financial team of LSUIC held a financial literacy program and a fundraiser, featuring guest speaker Chadwin P. Adams, a Chartered Accountant at Asia Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB), who shared insights on personal finance management and long-term financial planning. The event included presentations on building wealth, creating emergency funds, and developing 5-10-year financial strategies, with Accountant Adams emphasizing the importance of starting small and building financial discipline. 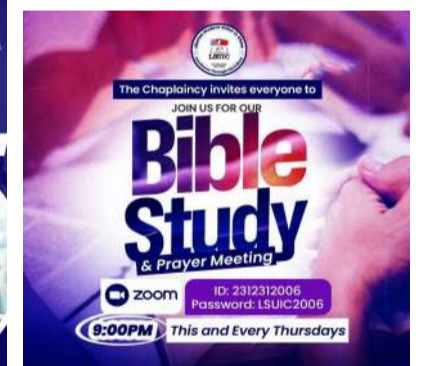
