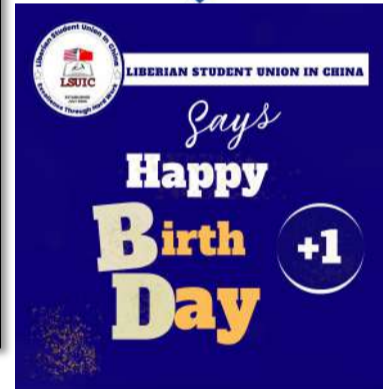

Scheduled for Friday, March 13, 2026, at 8:00 PM on the LSUIC Zoom Platform, the program will be held under the theme "Building Financial Futures: Advanced Strategies for Wealth & Wisdom." The initiative seeks to equip students with practical tools for budgeting,

smart investing, and long-term financial planning while studying abroad. The session will feature Mr. Chadwin P. Adams, a Chartered Accountant at Asia Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) as the guest speaker, who is expected to provide valuable insights on building financial discipline and creating sustainable wealth. The NFS say the program reflects LSUIC's continued commitment to strengthening the financial awareness of Liberian students in China, preparing them to become financially responsible leaders and contributors to national development.

**WINTER DEBATE MVP PRINCE Y. SAYDEE REFLECTS ON JOURNEY OF PERSISTENCE AND EXCELLENCE**



Honorable Prince Y. Saydee, the Most Valuable Player of the 2026 LSUIC Presidential Intercity Winter Debate, has described his victory as the result of perseverance, hard work, and collective support from the Liberian student community in China. Reflecting on his journey, Saydee recalled spending countless sleepless nights from February 7 to 28 preparing research, arguments, and resources for the tournament. He noted that his path to the MVP title was built over years of

determination, from placing third with his team in the 2024 Winter Debate, to winning the tournament in 2025 while narrowly missing the MVP award. Saydee expressed gratitude to the Academic Excellence Committee, judges, teammates, competitors, and supporters whose encouragement inspired him throughout the competition. He emphasized that debate goes beyond winning arguments, serving as a platform for critical thinking, dialogue, and the pursuit of truth.

**LEGACY HOUR 7.0 CELEBRATES LEADERSHIP AS DR. HASSAN WHITFIELD REFLECTS ON LSUIC PRESIDENCY**

The Liberian Students Union in China (LSUIC) successfully concluded Legacy Hour 7.0, a historic dialogue series honoring past leaders and reflecting on the Union's journey toward its 20th anniversary. 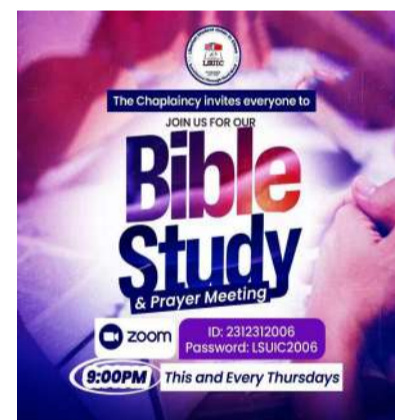
**LSUIC CELEBRATES HON. QUEENETTA DEAREST JOHNSON AS SCHOLAR OF THE WEEK**
