



LSUIC AUDIT COMMITTEE PRESENTS FINAL FINANCIAL AUDIT REPORT FOR 2023-2025



The LSUIC Audit Committee has presented its final report for 2023–2025, fulfilling a Bloh-Harmon leadership pledge to enhance transparency and accountability. Headed by Hon. Robert B. Kaba, the committee reviewed financial records and transactions, citing a lack of approved financial policy. Other issues included inadequate loan documentation, reporting discrepancies among officers, and unclear expenditure records.

Conference payments were not properly documented. The 2023–2024 report received an unqualified opinion, while the 2024–2025 report received a qualified opinion due to unresolved material misstatements. During the meeting, Hon. Jacob Cephus Johnson (former President, 2023-2025) stated that his then-Financial Secretary stole more than 38,000 RMB while he was in office.

THE JUDICIAL BOARD TAKES CHARGE OF LSUIC AUDIT FINDINGS, FINAL RULING EXPECTED SOON



The Judicial Board of the Liberian Students Union in China (LSUIC) has officially assumed responsibility for investigating issues from the Union’s 2023–2025 financial audit reports, following a formal request from the National Executive Committee (NEC) through the office of the National President, Hon. Olano Teah Bloh. The referral came after audit reviews, management responses, and a public Q&A session held on June 15, 2026. The reports flagged concerns, as mentioned in the above story. Upon as-

suming jurisdiction, the Judicial Board has commenced its investigation. A final judgment, along with corrective measures or sanctions, will be issued upon conclusion. The Board is vested with full independence and authority to conduct a fair, thorough probe without interference. The National Executive Committee (NEC) pledges full support. This case is a turning point for financial discipline and trust within the Liberian Student Union in China (LSUIC).

THE COUNCIL OF COORDINATORS (COC) GREENLIGHTS FIRST-EVER ONLINE VOTING PLATFORM

The Council of Coordinators (CoC) has officially approved the Independent Elections Commission’s (IEC) proposed online voting platform for the 2026 LSUIC General Elections, marking a significant step toward modernizing the Union’s democratic processes. The approval followed a joint deliberation between the CoC and IEC, during which the Commission’s efforts to address geographical and logistical barriers to voter participation were commended. The Council noted that the initiative aligns with LSUIC’s com-

mitment to inclusiveness, accessibility, and electoral transparency. To ensure the credibility of the process, the approval is subject to key conditions, including real-time monitoring of voting activities, publication of the final voter roll, enhancement of the platform’s user experience, and implementation of a hybrid voting system. The CoC reaffirmed its support for the initiative and expressed confidence that the reform will strengthen participation and confidence in LSUIC’s electoral system.
